For all retired Bishops, Priests, Deacons, Lay readers across the Traditional Anglican Church and in thanksgiving for their faithful service to Christ and His Holy Church.

Trinity 25 November 17th, 2024 For the unity of the Continuing Anglican Church around the world; that together we may effectively and faithfully witness to the historic Anglican expression of the Christian Faith.
